Visa	In most cases, the 'Student Visa' application can be done online via the Australian Embassy. Students can apply for a 'Student Visa' after receiving their Confirmation of Enrolment Number (COE-NO.) from ICMS.

Students receive the COE Request upon successful application. OSHC can be arranged for all other programs, but additional charges apply.
