Grading System	Final grades are determined by Grading Policy and the Assessment Policy and related procedures. Examples of assessments are: essays, case studies, presentations, group work and quizzes.

Application Deadline	Application documents should be sent to our European Office at least three to six months prior to your preferred start date. For a study abroad term at ICMS, please also mind internal deadlines at your home institution.								
Visa	In most cases, the 'Student Visa' application can be done online via the Australian Embassy. Students can apply for a 'Student Visa' after receiving their Confirmation of Enrolment Number (COE-NO.) from ICMS.

Insurance	The Australian health insurance ('Overseas Student Health Cover' = OSHC) is compulsory for every international student on a 'Student Visa' and is included in the 'Bachelor Study Abroad Package (4 Subjects)', if requested on the COE Request. Students receive the COE Request upon successful application. OSHC can be arranged for all other programs, but additional charges apply.
