Startdates & Deadlines

The Bachelor and Master are divided into trimesters (approx. 13 weeks) with three possible start dates per year: February, May and August. Current term dates are available on the ICMS website. Application documents should be sent to our European Office at least three to six months prior to your preferred start date. For a study abroad term at ICMS, please also mind internal deadlines at your home institution. Upon request, applications can be accepted until shortly before the start of term.

Visa

In most cases, the 'Student Visa' application can be done online via the Australian Embassy. Students can apply for a 'Student Visa' after receiving their Confirmation of Enrolment Number (COE-NO.) from ICMS.

Internships	Students from partner institutions who take a minimum of 30 ECTS at ICMS during their semester abroad are eligible to enroll in the WIL (Work Integrated Learning) program. This program allows them to complete a full-time internship in Australia for an additional trimester at no extra cost. The ICMS WIL team supports students in securing an internship placement in Australia.
Scholarships & Funding	The European Office of ICMS awards scholarships on a regular basis. Further scholarships may be offered by your government or other organizations in your home country. In Australia, student visa holders are allowed to work up to 24 hours per week during the term and up to 40 hours per week during term breaks.
