Proposed SEMO MBA Curriculum for UCLL BANABA

Required courses

The MBA program consists of 33 credits. UCLL Banaba students have to take 21 credits only spread across 2 semesters

Dissertation	BA657 Applied Research Project (can be based on Banaba Junior Consultant Project) (3 credits)

Study period

Fall intake	9 months study from 3 rd week of August till mid of May
Spring intake	9 months study form 3 rd week of January till mid of May and from 3 rd week of August till mid of December

Admission Requirements

- BANABA degree (without tolerable fails)
- GMAT score ≥ 500 (can be done in Brussels – Cost: \pm \$250)
- Proficient in English. TOEFL or IELTS may be waived
- \pm \$250 application fee
- An F1 visa (student visa) is preferred to a J1

Cost and fees

- Tuition fee: will be around \$11,000 for the MBA program (21 credits * \$526)
- Accommodation: \pm \$450 per month
- Other costs (travelling and living costs): up to \$5,000

Graduate Assistantship (GA)

A GA offers the opportunity to work for the University during their studies. This way they can earn a substantial fee. Positions are very limited and is offered to students who can prove excellent performance in previous studies

Application deadline

- 1 February (if you apply for GA) or 1 May for Fall intake
- 1 September for Spring intake
