OF THE PROJECT



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
The project aims to create an innovative e-learning for teachers from all over Europe on how to manage multiculturalism in classrooms

The online training will be composed by two modules: one with awareness-raising activities on multiculturalism and diversity and one on CLIM methodology to be applied in classes




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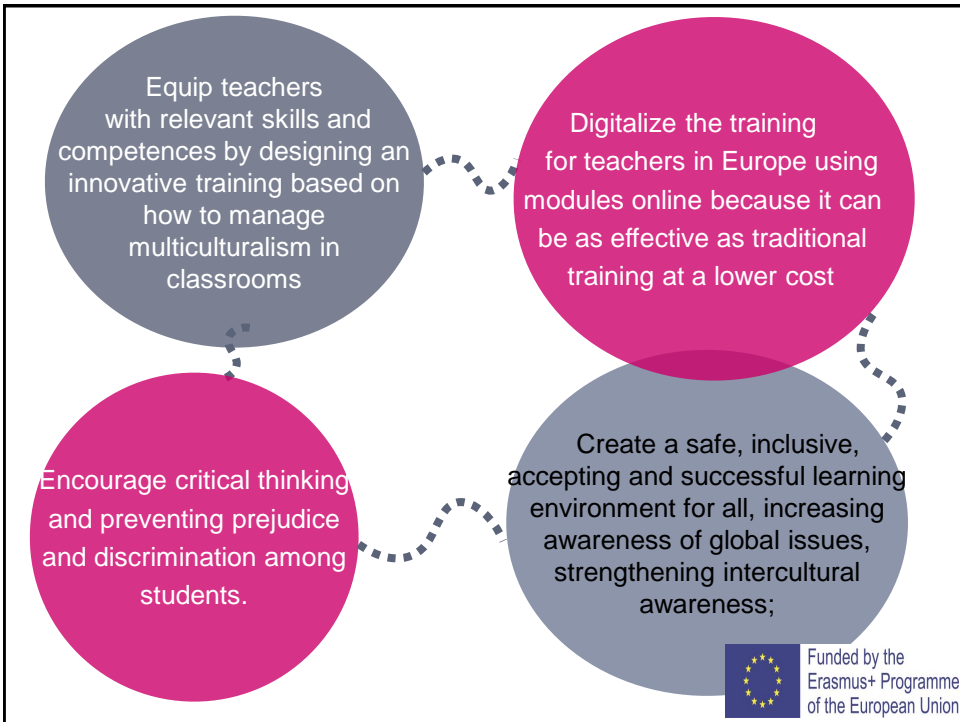

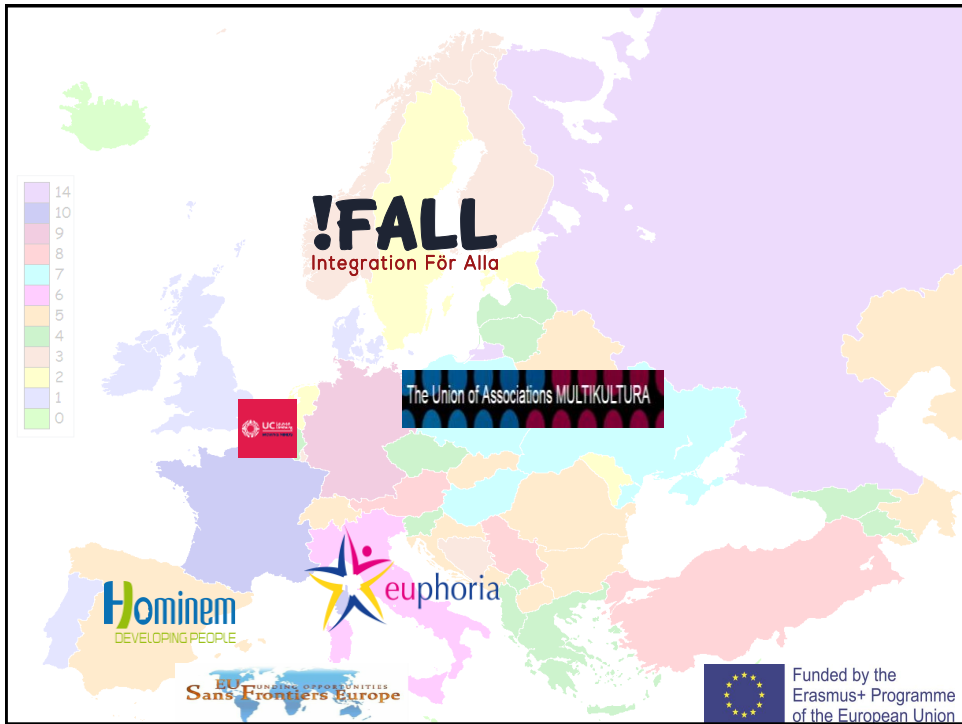

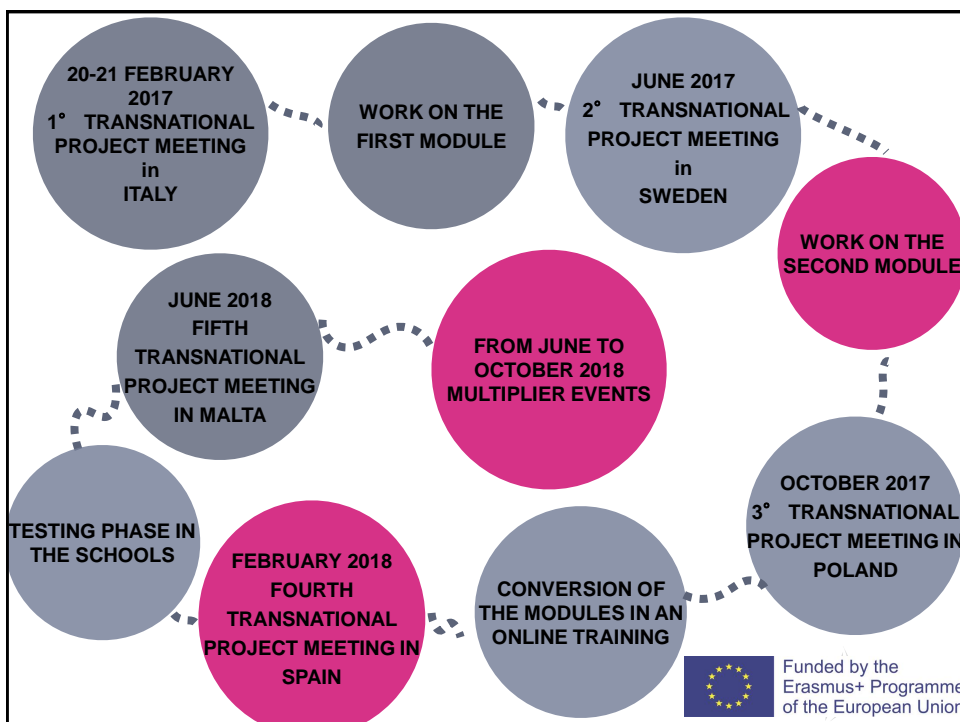
